If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Board of Adjustment with respect to any matter considered at such meeting, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. An appeal must be filed within thirty (30) calendar days after the hearing by filing a formal appeal with the Circuit Court for the Tenth Judicial Court.
